

THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

I. PURPOSE

The School Board recognizes the need to provide instruction in the proper etiquette, display, and respect of the United States flag. The purpose of this policy is to provide for recitation of the pledge of allegiance and flag etiquette instruction to help further that end.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

Students in this school shall recite the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America one or more times each week. The recitation shall be conducted:

- A. By each individual classroom teacher or the teacher's surrogate; or
- B. At an assembly, over the intercom, or via LILAvision by a person designated by the school director or other person having administrative control over the school.

III. EXCEPTIONS

Any student or teacher may decline to participate in recitation of the pledge of allegiance to the flag. Employees or students, who choose not to participate, will sit or stand quietly and respectfully during the recitation. Students must be respectful of the choice to not recite the pledge.

IV. INSTRUCTION

Students will be instructed in the proper etiquette toward, correct display of, and respect for the flag.
